- 1998, June 1st The ministry of Industry and Commerce, Invest-Quebec, Statistics Quebec : Problematical Elements Interconnected. Since few years, a current question concerned the creation of a ministry of the Economy. The government have already created a super minister structure, named the State ministry of the Economy and Finance, regrouping the ministry of Industry and Commerce, the ministry of Finances and the ministry of Revenue. This document illustrates how the evolution of the ministry of Industry and Commerce towards a truly ministry of the Economy is not dissociated of Invest Quebec and Statistics Quebec.
- 1998, May, 6th Clarification of the canvassing functions with the functions of industrial development agents and regional development agents (or difference in the leading roles of the Ministry of Industry and Commerce and Invest Quebec). Because the creation of Invest Quebec is occurred at the same time of the conception of a new management private investment system (the SYGIP), it became necessary to clarify the canvassing functions under Invest Quebec (or head-hunters concerning the investments), in comparison of the functions conducted by the experts in the ministry having daily contacts with the enterprises. This document illustrates the complementarity between the two organisations.

- 1998, February, 15th Creation of an administrative unit at the ministry of Industry and Commerce having the mandate to realise strategic analysis with a medium and long term vision. This document is the first one illustrating the problematic involved across the overall governmental administration, and mainly in the ministry of Industry and Commerce, with the cessation of the expertise in quantitative analysis and economic forecasting, as before 1990. This document justified the authorities to mandate a team of professors at the CREFA (University of Laval) to check the assertions. Their final report dated may 15th, 1998 concluded in the same way with more arguments.

The ministry of Industry and Commerce has never had a management system to organise the data about his clientele. This document illustrated the necessity for the Ministry to have a sophisticated instrument to manage correctly with efficiency, simultaneously with the implementation of a new management private investment system (the SYGIP).
- 1997, October, 9th Appreciation of a research report made by the firm URBATIC inc. and submitted to the “Commission de la Capitale nationale”. The “Commission de la Capitale nationale” has requested to the ASDEQ (Quebec Economists Association) for an objective point of view concerning the methodology used to evaluate their choice of investments in the national capital. I have been personally chosen for that evaluation by the ASDEQ of the Quebec Region.
- 1994, April Toward a proposal to organise the Statistical Analysis in Quebec. This study, at very limited circulation level, has served to justify the new Quebec Statistic Agency called « l’Institut de la statistique du Québec » (or Statistique Québec).
